Compassionate, non-judgmental, practical and supportive care is provided *free of charge* and with *complete confidentiality*.

We respond to the level of greatest need on which our clients are focused at any given time, whether that be:

- **Options Counselling** re:
  - ✓ the joys and challenges of **parenting**
  - ✓ the benefits and struggles of **adoption**
  - ✓ the facts and consequences of **abortion**
- **Pregnancy Tests & Information** about sexually transmitted infections
- **Provision** of maternity clothes, baby clothes, blankets, formula, diapers etc.
- **Referrals** for pre-natal care, social and adoption services, housing and financial needs, pastoral care, professional care, and post-abortion stress counselling [Please note: We do not make referrals for abortion]
- **Emotional support and caring** through the pregnancy [for the pregnant woman, her boyfriend or husband, and parents ]
- **Post abortion support**
